



Confidentiality of Information Statement

As a student completing a clinical rotation at TidalHealth, Inc., you may have access to confidential and/or sensitive information about TidalHealth, its patients/residents and/or employees. Access to such information is a responsibility on your part, and as such, this information is protected by law and may not be revealed to any unauthorized person under any circumstances. TidalHealth makes reasonable efforts to limit the use, access or disclosure of or requests for protected health information to the “minimum necessary”. Unnecessary or inappropriate access to and disclosures of protected health information will be grounds for corrective action up to and including termination of your clinical rotation. Protected Health Information concerning a patient’s diagnosis and treatment must not be shared or discussed with anyone except those personnel and physicians directly responsible for the patient’s care. This includes fellow students or TidalHealth employees unless such individuals have a need and right to know. When you need to disclose confidential information to an authorized individual, you should be careful not to disclose the information in a public area or where there is a likelihood of being overheard. The privacy rule applies to personal health information in any form, including information transmitted orally, in writing or in electronic format.

Any student who is assigned a computer user code/password will use this code as an electronic signature for all computer transactions and must not divulge this code to any other student/employee. By having access to TidalHealth’s computer systems, you are also responsible for ensuring that no unauthorized individual is allowed to have access to the computer system. Students must not divulge confidential information, to which they may have access, to any unauthorized source.
