Patrick Dougherty, PharmD, BCPS, BCEMP

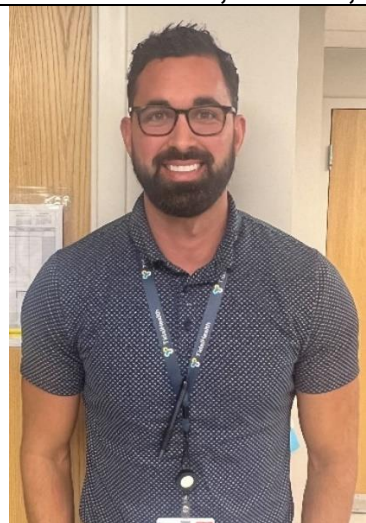
